



MELDED AND MANIPULATED SURFACES

Supplies you will need to bring:

- Disposable gloves
 - Apron or old clothes
 - 3-4 large brown paper bags or brown Kraft paper
 - Newspaper to cover table
 - 1 roll of waxed paper and 1 roll of plastic wrap
 - Scotch tape and masking tape
 - Pen, scissors - one pair for paper, one pair for fabric
 - 2 bowls: a small one for water, another of your choice to use as a mold
 - ◆ Small sponge
 - Small box: Kleenex size or paperback book size
 - Cardboard: small piece for template 7" x 7"
 - ◆ Tacky Glue: large bottle and part of another
 - Selection of fabrics (1/2 yard each), including a stiff fabric such as taffeta, AND
 - ◆ Sheer fabric such as organza or tulle (net)
 - ◆ Scraps of ribbons, yarns, trims, etc.
 - ◆ Paint: some metallics or pearlized such as Jacquard, Nova or Deka
 - ◆ Brushes, including at least one stencil brush - any size except extra large
 - Doilies, screens, open weave ribbon to stencil through. Bring whatever you find; I will bring some for experiment.
 - A few pins, paper clips, ruler (optional)
 - ◆ Plaster bandage (Rigid Wrap)
 - Optional: glitter, crayons, handmade or fancy paper
