Supplies you will need to bring:

Silk to experiment on: several pieces, approximately 20" x 20". Possibilities: china silk is less expensive; crepe de chine is an excellent all-purpose silk.

You are making an "art material" that can be cut up and used on something else, so you won't be wasting your time or materials.

Cardboard or plastic container to work over

- ◆ Silk paints: Jacquard or Deka, assorted colors

- ◆ Brushes, sponges to apply paints

Small plastic cups or jars for paints

- ◆ Disposable gloves

Apron

Paper to cover table

Silk pens

- ◆ Scissors

A selection of materials to inspire creativity: rubber bands, thread, needle, bag clamps, rubber stamps, stencils, eraser to carve and knife to carve it

Previously dyed materials

Discharge paste

- ◆ Fabrics to applique

- ◆ Fabric paints: Jacquard, Deka or Nova textile paints

Hair dryer
